PRUkasih Program

In the fourth quarter of 2019, GVCA focused in servicing the community through claims, with 29 claims for illnesses, accidents, and death filed, amounting to RM43,456 being disbursed to the affected members. 3 residents were newly enrolled in the program during the house visitations.





PRUKASIH BENEFICIARIES HIGHLIGHTS



MARIMUTHU (ACCIDENT CLAIM)

Mr Marimuthu works as a garbage collector. He accidentally cut his leg and caught an infection. Due to a swelling, he could not walk for many months. During his medical leave period, he uses the food and rental aid to support himself and his family as he recuperates.



MUTHUSAMY (ILLNESS CLAIM)

Mr Muthusamy worked as a driver. He was forced to amputate his leg due to diabetes and was out of job and in despair. Through the food and rental aid received and GVCA social worker's mental care support, he was temporary relieved financially and smiles are seen on his face again.



TAN (DEATH CLAIM)

Mdm Tan lost her husband in a motor accident. He was the main breadwinner for the family and their disabled son. She was in deep despair after losing her loving husband. As a beneficiary to her late husband, Mdm Tan received condolence money, food, and rental aid to help her to cope during her time of difficulty.

Didik-Kasih EduCare Program

In fourth quarter of 2019, there were 21 candidates enrolled with the program, aimed at providing needy students with a startup assistance of RM1,500 and monthly study allowances for their tertiary education, while also guiding them to plan and conduct a charity project to give back to the society.
