Shopping Buddy Program

In the first quarter of 2023, our Shopping Buddy program extended support to 60 families from PPR Hicom to ease their burden. Every month, our team of volunteers acted as the shopping buddies to shop and delivery groceries for 20 different low-income families selected, where each family will be provided with RM200 worth of customised groceries that are self-picked by each of the respective families to give them a well-balanced nutritional diet intake.

During the Meet & Greet session, the students participated in an ice breaking activity to get to know one another, before being briefed about the Didik-Kasih program, their roles to play as a participating volunteer, as well as guidelines on conducting their own charity projects. All the students attending were happy to finally meet up with one another. Although all of them were from different backgrounds and fields of studies, they were able to share their knowledge and experiences, get to know each other, and discuss their potential team charity projects together. The students also get to strengthen their existing bond with their peers and mentors over a luncheon session together. By the end of the Meet & Greet session, they are closer to one another, with some even registering themselves on the spot as volunteer for their peers' upcoming charity projects.
