GVCA also initiated activities to foster closer bonds among the students and mentors. All the students attending were happy to finally meet up with one another. Despite their diverse backgrounds and areas of study, they exchanged knowledge and experiences, and explored potential collaborative charity project. Furthermore, they deepened their connections with fellow students and mentors over a lunch together. By the end of the Meet & Greet session, they grew even closer, with some signing up as volunteers for their peers' upcoming charitable projects.







SPECIAL UPDATE - DIDIK-KASIH EDUAID LAUNCH

In Mar 24, GVCA commemorated the introduction of the Didik-Kasih EduAid program, offering sponsored intensive classes to selected students from SK Pelabuhan Utara for 12 months. During the ceremony, the GVCA President and the Principal of SK Pelabuhan Utara signed a Memorandum of Understanding as a mutual agreement for collaboration. GVCA agreed to provide allowances to teachers and free lunch for the students attending the classes. The event was also attended by parents and teachers to have an overview of the classes, led by GVCA Program Team Lead, Ms. Nazihah, followed by assessments conducted with parents to better understand their family backgrounds.
