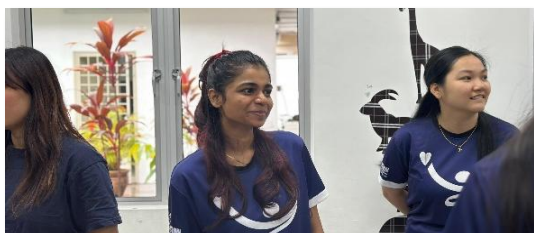
MUHAMMAD IRFAN BIN ALJAHARI

KAVITHA AMBHIGAY A/P ALAGAN

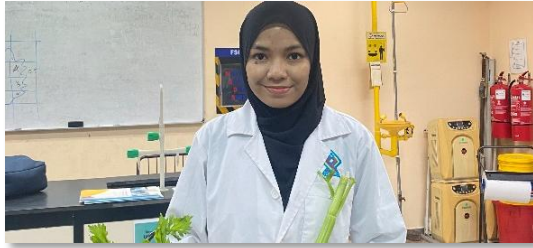

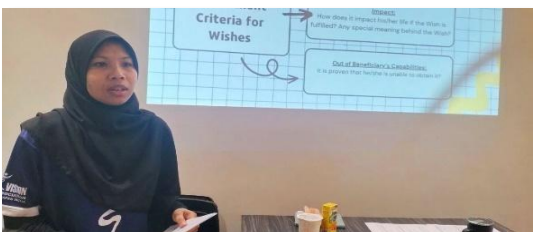
NURUL RAQIQAH BINTI RIDWAN
