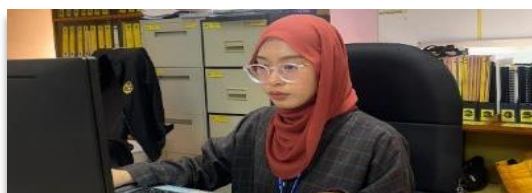
NG JUN LER

TEAMBUILDING AND BONDING WITH DIDIK-KASIH EDUCARE STUDENTS

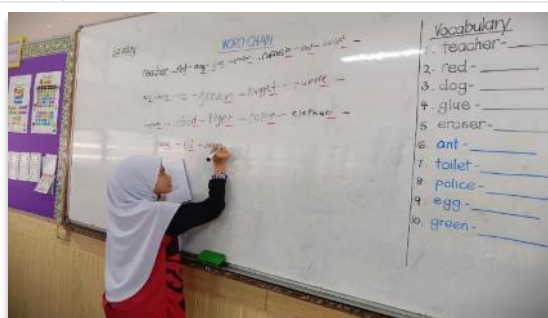
