Shopping Buddy Program

In the fourth quarter of 2025, our Shopping Buddy Program extended support to 40 low-income families whose children study at the Sekolah Kebangsaan Pelabuhan Utara (SKPU), with our dedicated volunteers serving as both chauffeur and shopping buddies to the families that they were paired with. Each grocery session was designed not only to assist with transportation and shopping logistics but also to provide meaningful guidance. Every family was allocated RM200 to purchase essential items, while volunteers offered advice on how to make healthier choices and maintain a well-balanced nutritional diet through their grocery selection.

Kavitha studies Business Management. In Oct 25, her studies completed and her aid ended. She is now on internship with Allianz, handling policy processing, customer services, and workflows.

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
NUR ALFADINA BINTI MOHD BORHAN

HEARTS OF COMPASSION WITH IIUM

On 1 Nov 25, 24 IIUM students organised the Hearts of Compassion project to nurture spiritual, emotional, and intellectual growth through community engagement. The initiative provided life skills such as emotional awareness, communication, social skills, self-confidence building, teamwork, and problem-solving for 35 needy children and foster volunteerism and leadership among students.

The children's mothers were also invited for one of the sessions, where they bonded and cook together with their children.
